REGULATIONS FOR FAST & ABSTINENCE 2018

DAYS OF FAST & ABSTINENCE: ASH WEDNESDAY (February 14) & GOOD FRIDAY (March 30)

DAYS OF ABSTINENCE: ALL FRIDAYS IN LENT

ABSTINENCE: Age of 14 and older. NO MEAT may be eaten.

FAST: 18 to 60 years old. Only ONE FULL MEAL, two partial meals.

EASTER DUTY

All Catholics in good standing must receive Holy Communion at least once a year, especially during the Easter Season, February 17-18 through May 19-20, 2018

Those in serious (Mortal) sin are also required to receive confession.

LENTEN SELF-DENIAL APPEAL: Use daily during Lent!

During the Season of Lent, you are asked to use a plain envelope and mark on it your name and the words: Lenten Self-Denial. Place it in a prominent place in your home (family table) and place offerings (alms) of change or bills in it each day representing sacrifices that you make during the Season of Lent. (Giving up candy, beverage, movie, snack, meal, etc.). Your change, bill or check represents your sacrifices. Count up the sacrifices and make out a check or place a bill for that amount in the envelope and deposit it in any collection basket on Palm Sunday Weekend, Holy Thursday, Good Friday or Easter. They may also be taken or mailed to the Parish Office. Use your own plain envelope and mark it: LENTEN SELF-DENIAL.

A gift of \$10.00, \$15.00, \$20.00 or \$25.00 would be appreciated.

Almsgiving is a hallmark of Lent. This represents about .25 to .50 each day of Lent.

HOLY WEEK OBSERVANCE: MARCH 24 THROUGH APRIL 1, 2018

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD – MARCH 24-25, 2018

- Blessing & Distribution of Palm during all regular weekend Masses. The year you will take UNBLESSSED PALM as you enter the Church. Palm will be blessed at the beginning of every Mass.
- Small blessed palm crosses will be distributed to every person at weekend Masses.

HOLY THURSDAY- MARCH 29, 2018 – 7 PM

- Mass of the Lord's Last Supper & Solemn Procession.
- Presentation of the Sacred Oils, Blessed Bread Distributed to every person at the Mass of the Lord's Last Supper to share with family and friends at home.
- Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Chapel Gym until 10 PM
- Washing of the Feet of twelve parishioners: First Holy Communion students, Confirmation Students and Male & Female Adults.
- Rosary & Night Prayer at 9:30 PM with Knights of Columbus and Deacon Maurice.

GOOD FRIDAY – MARCH 30, 2018 – 1 PM

- Morning Prayer with Deacon Maurice – 9 AM
- Celebration of the Lord's Passion – 1 PM (Passion, Veneration of Cross & Communion)
- The final opportunity for Confession before Easter will follow from 2-2:30 PM.
- No scheduled Stations of the Cross on Good Friday. They may be prayed privately in Church or at home.

HOLY SATURDAY – MARCH 31

- **NO CONFESSIONS WILL BE HEARD TODAY!**
- Morning Prayer with Deacon Maurice– 9 AM
- Blessing of Family Easter Food Baskets in the Gym - 1 PM
(A handout will be distributed as an insert in the parish bulletin on the weekend of March 17-18 that explains what goes into a traditional Easter Food Basket and its symbolism.)

SOLEMN EASTER VIGIL – Saturday, MARCH 31, 2018 – 8 PM (NO EARLIER VIGIL MASS)

Blessing of the new fire, lighting of the new Paschal Candle and individual candles, blessing of the water and Renewal of Baptismal Promises. No RCIA Candidates this year. This year a plastic 4 ounce Holy water Container will be given to each family. You are invited to take one and fill it after mass with the newly blessed Easter Water at the baptismal font. This container should be taken to church every year to be refilled with the blessed Easter Water for use in your home.

EASTER SUNDAY: APRIL 1, 2018 ~ Renewal of Baptismal Promises

Masses will be celebrated at 7:30, 9 & 11:30 AM
Easter Water is available before & after all Masses.
